
Our Nursery pupils are settling into a lovely routine of plenty of play and singing and it is wonderful to see them coming in happy and smiling.

Covid 19 Update

If your child has one of the 3 Cardinal Symptoms:

New / Continuous cough

Temperture

Loss of taste or smell

They must NOT come to school and you will need to book a PCR test. Please keep your child at home until there has been a negative test.

If your child has a positive lateral flow test, they must NOT come to school and you will need to book a PCR test. As we are no longer in class bubbles – Test and Trace will be identifying contacts, working together with school and home.

In general children under 18 will not need to isolate if they are a close contact unless they have symptoms.

Breakfast club will start back on 20th September. Doors open at 8.20am and close at 8.30 am. There will be a booking system and please only use this service if it is essential.
