
**Change again ... Year 1 Entry & Exit door will return to the Hall door. We tried a change, it didn't work so let's go back.**



- \*Fruit is available at break time. Fruit is 30p a day or £1.50 per week.
- \*Please provide your child with a bottle of water. We have fresh drinking water when they need to top up. Our Healthy School's Policy asks us to promote the drinking of water and I ask you to support us in this by only providing water for your child.

Breakfast club now runs every day. Doors open at 8.20am and close at 8.30 am. There is a booking system in place and places need to be booked via text on a Monday for the following week. Please only use this service if it is essential. Entry will be through the hall door only.
