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Dear Parents and Carers,

I am pleased to inform you that we will be opening a free Breakfast Club to pupils in Reception to Year 6 on Monday 20th September. It will be open at 8.20am every day. (Children arriving after 8:30am will not be permitted).

Due to current Covid 19 regulations in school's we are limited to the number of spaces we can offer. Please only use the Breakfast Club if it is essential.

Parents will be required to accompany children to the entrance of the hall where they can sign in. If your child does not attend on 3 occasions (unless parents have informed the school), we will allocate your child's place to someone on the waiting list.

Children will sit in class bubbles and will have a restricted menu, of toast, yoghurt and juice. Their breakfast will be brought to the table to avoid unnecessary movement. No activities are allowed at present but we will play music to help entertain the children. As the Breakfast Club is run by BCBC I must adhere to these strict guidelines, as is written in the Risk Assessment.

Please text the school number to book your child's place in Breakfast Club.

Due to restricted numbers all applications need to be returned by 9am on Wednesday 14th September. Applications after this deadline cannot be accepted. You will be told if your booking has been successful and will need to sign a form which will be sent home with your child. Please ensure this is returned by Thursday 16th September.

Reminders;

- The school day for all children begins at **8.55am**. Doors are open from 8.45am and children will come straight in off the yard. Please ensure they arrive on time in order to get into class and settle down to their lessons.
- Please inform the school if your child is absent due to illness. If your child is feeling unwell, they should stay at home until they feel well again.
- Fruit is available at break time at the cost of 30p. Please ensure your child has something to eat before coming to school and/or fruit for play time.
- Please provide your child with a bottle of water. We have fresh drinking water when they need to top up. Our Healthy School's Policy asks us to promote the drinking of water, and I ask you to support us in this by only providing water for your child to drink.
