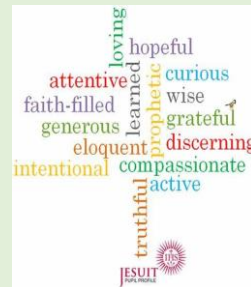
Sacrament of Holy Communion
